COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FORUM REPORT

Date: July 2025

Anti-social behaviour – Abbeywood Retail Park still has most of the issues. These are usually linked to problems with youths around McDonalds and nuisance vehicles. PCSOS continue to patrol the area.

Patrols are continuing around Elm Park following reports of nuisance bikes. While at the recent talk to us event, the bike was sighted but police were unable to get close to the vehicle. There was the recent report of graffiti in Elm Park which showed support for Palestine. This has been highlighted to the police counter terrorism team for intelligence and monitoring.

Talk to Us Event was held at the leisure centre on 11th July. The next event is planned for the 8th August. This will be at 17:30 hours at the leisure centre.

Community Engagement- PCSO Soandro has been involved in two school fete events at Filton Hill school and Shield Road school.

There is a plan to carry out a week of action at the start of August. The focus will be on E bikes and scooters.

Crime Statistics for the month up until the 23/07 there has been 65 reported crimes in the Filton area. For the previous month there were 77 offences reported.

The amount offences reported are down compared to this time last year. In June 2024 there were 92 reported offences.

In the last 28 days there have been 6 arrests for 12 offences. Burglary offences have continued to fall compared to earlier in the year. Of the 15 theft offences, 4 of them were theft from shops.

There was a report of indecent exposure in Elm Park. Police attended and arrested a suspect. This suspect was interviewed in custody and released under investigation for a decision to be made.
