COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FORUM REPORT

Anti-Social Behaviour –

The area with the most calls has been Abbey Wood Retail Park. This has been the usual calls of youths causing issues in McDonalds and reports of persons searching through the industrial waste bins. CCTV has been reviewed for these incidents and increased patrols in the area. Patrols and monitoring are continuing around Elm Park for nuisance bikes and drug use. A request for additional resources has been made and it is hoped that some planned operations may take place.

Talk to Us Event was held at the leisure centre on Friday 13th June. This was covered by PCSO'S from the Patchway area as I had been abstracted to assist in Bath. The next talk to us event is planned for 17:30 hours on 11th July.

Community Engagement – Patrols have been continued in and around primary schools during drop off and pick up. Patrols were increased around Filton Hill school following a recent report of a possible accident.

The team were also helping with the reassurance patrols around Cribbs Causeway following the stabbing incident. Assistance was also given to increase patrols around the local secondary schools and the team have been involved in arrest of suspects for the offence.

Crime Statistics For the month of June up until the 19th, there has been 36 reported offences in the Filton area.

Last month 87 offences were recorded which was a drop on the previous two months where over 100 offences were recorded in April and March.

There have been 4 reported burglaries for the month. There is no link to the offences, and two offences were not actually a burglary.

There have been 2 vehicle offences reported this month. Of the 7 theft offences recorded so far, only 1 offence relates to shop theft.

There have been 7 arrests this month for 18 offences.

The crime statistics are taken direct from our police recording system and are for the Filton area only. Other crime statistics websites show figures for the whole of South Gloucestershire area.
