COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FORUM REPORT

Date: September 2025

Anti-social behaviour – ASB issues continue in and around Elm park, though not as many incidents as at the start of the summer. Patrols are continuing in and around this area.

Concerns had been raised about ASB issues linked to the shops on Gloucester Road North, Northville. The area will be monitored and issues to be discussed with trading standards.

There has also been concerns regarding disturbances from short term rentals and private rental properties in the area. The properties have been visited, the landlords and agents have been spoken to, and South Gloucestershire council private sector housing have been informed of the problems. The addresses will be continuously visited and patrolled.

Talk to Us Event was held at the leisure centre on 8th August and the 5th of September. We are starting to get more engagement from the public, due to the events been publicised. The next event is at 17:30 on Friday 3rd October

Community Engagement- School talk conducted on the 22nd September. Increase in school patrols around all three primary schools around parking issues.

SGS college Freshers event attended and bike marking event carried out.

Crime Statistics for the month up until the 25/09 there has been 69 reported crimes in the Filton area. For the previous month there were 95 offences reported. The amount offences reported in August have increased compared to August last year.

In the last 28 days there have been 6 arrests for 9 offences. Burglary offences have increased over the last two months. There is no pattern to location, with offences spread across Filton. The only common link is a report of two suspicious males seen at some offences and also seen trying car doors.

Please can all suspicious incidents be reported to the police. Also, can I ask residents to make sure doors and vehicles are secured with valuable not visible in vehicles.

Of the 11 theft offences, 3 of them were theft from shops, this has been a steady decrease since the start of the summer.

The **StreetSafe** tool has been introduced as part of the Government's response to tackling violence against women and girls. It identifies public spaces where you have felt or feel unsafe, because of issues such as anti-social behaviour (for example being verbally abused or followed) and environmental issues (for example lack of street lighting, abandoned buildings or vandalism).
